Lakeview Leadership Academy offers all students the opportunity for Academic Tutoring, Sports and enrichment classes through the ASES program. Lakeview students who participate in ASES are monitored individually in academics, discipline and attendance daily. Our ASES Program works in collaboration with our Sports and many other academic programs and events sponsored by Lakeview Leadership Academy. Many of these events may require direct or indirect supervision by ASES staff. *Completion of this form is mandatory if a student requires the use of any ASES resources or plans to participate in any afterschool event. ASES resources include but are not limited to bus service, afterschool supper, and supervision or office access after 4:30 p.m. (Lakeview office is officially closed at 4:30 p.m.) The ASES Program and office hours runs every school day immediately upon the conclusion of the school day. The 2018-2019 ASES Program starts Monday, August 6th 2018 and ends Wednesday, May 29th 2019. Completion of this form is not an automatic quarantee of enrollment. Program approval is determined upon available space and may be denied after an evaluation of student's discipline record. PARENTS AGREE AND ARE AWARE OF THE FOLLOWING:

- Students with 2 or more current "Assertive Discipline" infractions are disqualified from ASES, but may be eligible for temporary support if participating in special events or team sports. All applicants will be interviewed.
- ASES begins August 6, 2018 and runs every school day throughout the year from 3:41pm-6:41pm. Each student must take an Academic class as well as an Enrichment class each day unless attending a special event, specialized class, or enrolled in a sports activity. ASES is grant funded. ASES students must sign into the program regardless of length of stay, outside or school events or appointments.
- Transportation is offered for <u>ALL</u> students at 6:00 pm each evening. Parents must ensure that their student knows their bus route. Parents may pick their child up @ or before 6:00 P.M. if an Early Release Policy is signed.
- ASES is not a compulsory but a "privileged program." This criterion applies to our staff. Acceptance of applicants is conditional. We are an exceptional program with high expectations in the character of our students.
- A healthy supper snack is provided each day during our designated break time.
- Parents will be notified if a student becomes ill or is injured, or if program is cancelled. ASES does not offer child
 care services. Students placed at risk when emergency contacts are not kept current may be dropped from the
 program.
- "Leader In Me" strategies (Being Respectful/Responsible & Accountable) will be stressed at all times.
- Students who engaged in fighting, violence of any kind and inappropriate language will be dropped without warning from the program. Administrative Regulation 5144 and Education Code 48900.
