EARLY RELEASE/LATE ARRIVAL POLICY 2019-2020:

Early Release: When picking up a student for Early Release, the parent or other designee listed on the students enrollment form or student's record must come to the office, sign out the student, write the time of day, and state the reason. A valid ID is required when checking students out. A student may be excused from the after school program before 6:46 p.m. for the following reasons:

- 1. Off-Site Enrichment 2. Family Emergency 3. Family Needs 4. Medical Appointment 5. Transportation
- 6. Child Accident/Injury 7. Safety Issues (darkness, weather) 8. Athletic program/team sports

Late Arrival: A student is to report directly to their class, special event, or sporting event with a teacher or approved staff as soon as the regular school day ends. **Students are NOT allowed to leave campus and return to school for a program unless brought in late by a parent or approved LLA field trips or away games.** This is to ensure the safety of our students. A student may arrive late to the After School Program after 3:46 p.m. for the following reasons:
